Cambridge Technical Level 3

Course Overview

This new vocational qualification in IT is the equivalent to one A Level. It has been designed to include refreshing and exciting content, that's up to date, engaging, fit for purpose and suitable for the needs of your students in 2019 and beyond. The course has been developed in consultation with universities, employers and industry specialists to make sure that students will gain the right combination of knowledge, understanding and skills required for the 21st century.

The qualifications aim to develop your knowledge, understanding and skills of the principles of IT and Global Information Systems. Students will gain an insight into the IT sector as they investigate the pace of technological change, IT infrastructure, and the flow of information on a global scale, and the importance of legal and security considerations. The Level 3 Cambridge Technicals in IT focus on the requirements that today's universities and employers demand and can lead onto a range of IT degrees or IT related careers.

Entry Requirements

Students are required to meet the base entry criteria for the Sixth Form (five 5-9 Grades). The units are graded Pass, Merit and Distinction. The qualification is graded P, M, D, D*.

Units

Unit 1, 2 and 3 are mandatory

- Unit 1: Fundamentals of IT
- Unit 2: Global Information
- Unit 3: Cyber Security - externally examine

A choice of two further units which are centre-assessed and moderated by OCR.

NB: This course will only be available if numbers demand.
